West Baray is a rectangular shaped reservoir from the Angkor Wat period. Measuring approximately 7.8 by 2.1 kilometres, this is the largest Baray in Angkor. It is very impressive considering it is build by hand.

This is a very popular destination for locals to hang out and have picnic with their friends and family, especially on Sundays. Rent a small bamboo hut with hammocks, relax and enjoy the happiness of people playing in the water. Food stalls are available, where you can taste local fresh fruit, coconuts, chicken, fish, frogs - you name it!
