Don't forget that this is a holy place, and it is recommended to dress according to the local customs (cover your shoulders and knees).

Remember that the complex is visited by almost 3 millions tourists every year. Do not touch, remove or bring any rocks from the temple area.

The Angkor Archaeological Park is located just a few kilometres outside of Siem Reap. This majestic temple complex is on the UNESCO World Heritage List, and National Geographic considers the temple ruins as one of the three most important cultural attractions in the world. The complex is the home to over 300 magnificent temple ruins from the Angkorian era, including the world biggest religious building, Angkor Wat, and two other very famous temples Bayon and Ta Phrom.
