

# Outlying temples

**Banteay Srey** - located 38 km from Siem Reap, Banteay Srey is a small temple made of pink sandstone. The walls are covered with some of the most beautiful carvings of any Angkorian Temple.



**Kbal Spean, The Thousand Lingas** - located 50 km from Siem Reap. A lovely 2 km uphill jungle path will take you to this spectacular carved riverbed inside a beautiful river. The best time to visit this place is between September and December.



**Beng Melea** - 63 km east from Siem Reap lays Beng Melea. Few tourists visit this quiet and isolated temple. This gives you a chance to enjoy walking around in a temple almost by yourself. Entrance fee: \$5



**Rolous Group** - only 13 km from Siem Reap you'll find some of the earliest structures built by Khmer, dating from the late 9<sup>th</sup> century. Rolous Group is a collection of monuments representing the first major capital of the Angkorian era Khmer Empire.



We have for your convenience made two special tours for the outlying temples:

- Banteay Srey Tour (50Km)

Bantaey Srey and Kbal Spean (Thousand lingas river). While you are in this area, also visit the Landmine museum.



- Beng Melea Tour (70Km)

Enjoy this less visited temple along the outlying countryside. Combine it with a visit to Rolous Group.
